The dashboard will play a vital role in conveying environmental information to decision-makers, identifying emerging environmental issues, and addressing knowledge gaps related to environmental conditions and trends.

The Kuwait Dashboard project adds value to the humanitarian community in the following ways:

Enhanced Data Accessibility: The project facilitates easy access to a rich set of environmental data through an interactive dashboard. This user-friendly platform empowers humanitarian organizations to make informed choices crucial for disaster response and preparedness.
