



Ethiopia

CONTEXT

Ethiopia grapples with multiple humanitarian crises affecting over 21.4 million people, with 4.4 million displaced as of February 2024. While the Cessation of Hostilities brought improvements, the situation in northern Ethiopia remains unpredictable. Accumulated needs from two years of conflict persist, and areas in Tigray are still inaccessible. Beyond the northern crisis, other regions face severe issues, such as a worsening drought, conflict in Amhara and western Oromia, and humanitarian challenges in various regions. Limited coordination impedes effective assessments and analysis, risking duplication and inefficiency. Comprehensive information management is crucial for evidence-based decision-making and resource prioritization. Transforming data into organized information supports a collective understanding of the situation for informed responses.

3iSolution in Ethiopia

Since 2021, 3iSolution collaborated with OCHA, clusters, and government agencies, offering Information Management Support. 3iS provides data collection, visualization, mapping, and technical capacity-building services. In Ethiopia, we enhance IM capabilities through trained national IMOs, operating nationwide. Starting from 2022, 3iSolution is conducting IM capacitybuilding workshops for INGOs, NNGOs, UN agencies, and government entities at multiple locations. 3iS has forged partnerships with national and regional coordination structures, including the Ethiopia working groups, HINGO and national NGO coordination mechanisims.

Information Management Consortium

3iS currently leads an Information Management Consortium with partners REACH and ACAPS. 3iS provides timely support through an information support team with a focus on Protection cluster, addressing information management gaps, and developed an online platform for HINGO member which enable improved information sharing and decision-making. 3iSolution also provides capacity building to enhance the humanitarian response. IMPACT Initiatives will provides coordination, information management and assessment support to the humanitarian community through its inter-agency initiative REACH, with in-country operational support from ACTED. Within the action, the goal of REACH is to improve the quality of strategic decision making within the humanitarian coordination structure, and enhance the decisions made by the targeted individual organizations. ACAPS will provide independent humanitarian analysis, to create an evidence-base for decision-making at strategic, operational, and programmatic levels.
