





Factsheet 1 of 4 **Demographics and Disability**

Disability is defined as interactions between personal and environmental factors. It is measured by the level of functioning of a person in various areas of daily activities (called "domains") regardless of impairments, using the Washington Group tools.






Syrian refugees (aged 2+) in Jordan and Lebanon have disabilities

Disability prevalence is higher in young males than females in age groups 2-34 years, and in older females than males in age groups 35 years and above




DISABILITY AT HOUSEHOLD LEVEL

Almost one in three disabilities were acquired as a result of illness or disease


