Overview

The Protection Cluster - together with its Child Protection (CP), Gender-based Violence (GBV), Mine Action (MA) AoR's and Housing, Land and Property (HLP) Working Group – is working to prevent and mitigate protection risks and their harmful consequences, caused by conflict, severe drought, and food insecurity. The Cluster's 2023 PIN is 10.4M and from this 50% are targeted for protection related humanitarian assistance. % of the Cluster's target for 2023 has been reached so far. Despite some areas remaining significantly underserved, the Protection Cluster continues to work with partners and community-based structures to identify the most vulnerable peoples and address their needs.




